The Town of Olds invites you to attend an educational session on ***Minimum Residential Wiring Standards*** presented by ***John Graham, CLGM, President, eCom Services Ltd.***

The Olds Institute for Community and Regional Development (OICRD) is an independent public economic and community development governance board and sanctioned by the Town of Olds. OICRD's Technology Committee supports the development of a knowledge based Alberta community by the promotion of, and participation in, research and development and educational activities with respect to the communications networking infrastructure in Alberta.

In the spring of 2009, OICRD developed specifications for a ***Residential "Low Voltage" Construction Standard***. These specifications were prepared exclusively for use by persons involved in the construction of homes within the Town of Olds community. The specifications were developed using all reasonably available information with the goal of providing a minimum platform for the delivery of voice, data, and video services. However, telecommunication service definitions have undergone rapid change in the past and are expected to continue to do so. Therefore, it is the responsibility of each person involved in the construction of homes in the Town of Olds community to review these specifications periodically for any necessary updates as the content is subject to change.

The educational session will be held Monday, October 19, 2009 at the Bell-E Learning Centre on the Olds College Campus. This session will be from 4:30 - 6:00 pm with refreshments available.
